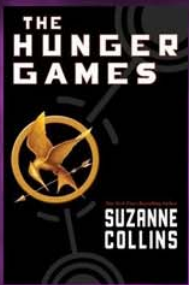
Going to Club Getaway in 7th Grade - Kristin
